RUSSIA OFFERS THE PUPPY "DOBRYNIA" IN TRIBUTE TO "DIESEL" POLICE DOG DECEASED IN COMBAT

Two days after the dangerous assault of Saint-Denis, the Ministry of the Russian Interior announced on Twitter that he would send a dog to replace Diesel, the deceased canine of police.-----

"In solidarity with the French police, during these troubled days, I ask you to accept the gift of our trainers, a policeman puppy, who will be able to integrate the ranks of your police dogs, instead of Diesel, killed in combat. I assure you of our commitment to strengthen cooperation in the fight against crime and terrorism" wrote the Ministry of the Russian Interior Minister Vladimir Kolokoltsev to French Interior Minister Bernard Cazeneuve.
